Suitable for Mercedes W124, 190 Series (W201), C-Class (W202, W203, W204), CLK (W208, W209), E-Class (W210) and S-Class (W140), rear axle.

Field of Application

The **KL-0043-11 B** pulling device enables the fast, simple and safe removal and installation of the joint bushes that are found on the specified rear axle wheel bearing housings, without the need for removing the latter from the vehicle.

🗥 Warnings and Notes

- Do not operate the tool by means of an impact wrench.
- Before use, lubricate spindle with molybdenum disulphide paste KL-0014-0030.
- Before putting the tool into operation, visually check to ensure that it is not damaged.

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Application example

Joint Bush Removal

- 1. Lift vehicle and loosen and/or remove components as may be necessary.
- 2. Mount tool as shown in Fig. 3 A.

Note:

Make sure that the openings in housing "1" are correctly positioned above the burr of the wheel bearing housing. Ensure that joint bush can be inserted into the inner diameter of the housing without touching the latter.

(see Fig. 3 B).

Choose suitable pressure piece "2" or "3" depending on type of vehicle. (see table Scope of Delivery)

 Extract joint bush by turning spindle "4" with shoulder nut "5".

Joint Bush Installation

- 1. Mount tool with new joint bush to wheel bearing housing as shown in **Fig. 4 A**.
- Make sure that the openings in housing "1" are correctly positioned above the burr of the wheel bearing housing. Ensure joint bush can be inserted into the inner diameter of the housing without touching the latter. (see Fig. 4 B)
- Insert joint bush by turning spindle "4" with shoulder nut "5". Stop the installation process as soon as the joint bush is positioned correctly.
- Remove tool, check the position of the joint bush and reassemble the vehicle according to the manufacturer's directions.



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
