


### **PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

#### KL-0186-24 - Injector extractor, Mercedes-Benz OM642

Suitable for Mercedes-Benz, Chrysler and Jeep with 3.0 litre 6-cylinder diesel engines of the OM642 series.

Installed e.g. in Mercedes-Benz C-Class (W203/S203, W204/S204), CLK-Class (C209/A209), CLS-Class (C219, C218), E-Class (W211/S211, W212/S212, W213), E-Class Coupé/Cabrio (C207/A207, C238/A238), G-Class (W461, W463), GL-Class (X164), GL-/GLS-Class (X166), GLC-Class (X253, C253), GLK-Class (X204), ML-Class (W164), ML/GLE-Class (W166, C292), R-Class (W251/V251), S-Class (W221/V221, W222/V222), Sprinter (B906, B907, B910), Vito/Viano (W639/V639), X-Class (W470); Chrysler 300C (LX/LE); Jeep Grand Cherokee (WK/WH), Commander (2006 - 2010).



### **APPLICATION EXAMPLE**

This application example describes how to remove a stuck injector using the injector extractor without dismantling the cylinder head.

1: Prepare injector...


#### ATTENTION

Contamination can get into the fuel system and the injectors and damage them. Therefore, always keep open fuel connections clean and protect them from contamination!

**1.** Prepare all parts required for removing the injector according to the manufacturer's instructions.

#### For example:

- Disconnect cable connectors
- Dismantling the fuel lines
- · Loosen the brackets on the injector




**©** 2: Unscrew the pull spindle on the injector...

### **ATTENTION**

The thread of the pull spindle [5] and the injector can be damaged. Therefore, always screw the pull spindle [5] completely onto the thread of the injector!

**2.** Screw the pull spindle [5] completely onto the injector in a clockwise direction as shown and tighten <u>lightly by hand</u> to **max. 5Nm.** 








#### **©**3: Assemble the injector extractor and fit in the correct position...

**3.** First assemble the injector extractor as shown, but do not yet tighten the collar nuts [3].



**4.** In the next step, place the injector extractor on the pull spindle [5] and ensure that the <u>three</u> support bolts [4] + [6] rest cleanly and evenly on the valve cover bolts on the cylinder head.



**5.** Then screw on the collar nut [1] by hand as far as it will go and tighten the collar nuts [3] to **5 Nm**.

#### 4: Pull out the injector in a controlled manner...



### **ATTENTION**

The thread of the pull spindle [5] can be damaged if it runs dry. Therefore, lubricate the pull spindle [5] with molybdenum disulphide paste (e.g. KL-0014-0030)!

**6.** To pull out the injector, turn the collar nut [1] clockwise using a suitable tool while simultaneously counterholding the pull spindle [5].

### Expert tip:

Treat extremely stuck injectors with rust remover and apply tension for a longer period of time. Alternately relieving the pressure and applying tension again should usually loosen the injector.
